## MEN'S SHIRT TURNED COUTURE BLOUSE

## MATERIALS

- » tulle in white and cream tones (http://bit.ly/2dqyk-zQ9)
- » leftover white organza
  (http://bit.ly/2dqyalH)
- » lace
- » strips of fabric
- » white mens shirt

## HOW-TO

- I. Upcycle an old men's shirt inspired by the "Victor and Rolf" couture collection (http://bit.ly/2dqyaIH)
- 2. Cut differently sized horizontal strips into the front parts (up to the waistline)
- 3. Cut differently sized strips from different fabrics
- 4. Weave strips into the front parts
- 5. Put different strips into the strips of the shirt you cut before
- 6. Sew the sides while adjusting the width to your liking
- 7. Cut out the lower parts of the front part
- 8. Take off the old collar and put on a new one from the fabric of your choice
- 9. Cut the strips
