MATERIALS


- » 0,5 m thick lining fabric
- » Elastic band (1,5 cm width) length according to your waist
- » 10 m tulle in dark sand (<http://bit.ly/2dRwBqU>)
- » 10 m tulle in light sand (<http://bit.ly/2dFGA4y>)
- » 2 m tulle in white (<http://bit.ly/2dFGIGz>)

HOW-TO

1. Sew petticoat without hemming the bottom seam or putting the elastic band on the waist
2. Determine desired length and start cutting the tulle, entire length – length of petticoat = length of tulle
3. Start with 8 panels of both colours, sew them onto the lower hem of the petticoat (right sides together). Don't sequence the fabric right away, instead fold it neatly while sewing for a better finish
4. Take another layer of tulle to sew onto lower hem in neat folds. Here, you can start varying in length. Neaten the hem.
5. Take differently sized (in length and width) pieces of tulle and sew them onto the petticoat in a spiral, until reaching the waist seam
6. Keep checking if the lengths look good
7. Put in the elastic band to finish the skirt (<http://bit.ly/2e08DLw>)




