## FLOWER BROOCH

## MATERIALS

- » Felt in colours of your choice the leaves:
  - Small = about 1,5 cm [about 9 individual ones]

Middle = about 2 cm (about 13 individual ones)

Big = about 3 cm [about 15 individual ones]

- » Scissors
- » Hot glue gun
- » Hairclip
  (from a craft shop)
- » Pencil
- » Cardboard

## TUTORIAL

- I. Cut out a cardboard stencil and trace the shape on your piece of felt. It should roughly look like a petal with a pointed tip. You will also need a circle of felt for the back.
- 2. Apply glue from the hot glue gun at the straight rim.
- 3. Lightly press the petals together till the glue sets.
- 4. Secure with clips until they're dried.
- 5. Use the hot glue gun to apply the petals to the circle, starting with the biggest ones on the outside.
- 6. The number of petals needed depends on how big you cut them. This also makes it possible to change the size of the flower. For the middle of the flower, roll up a leftover piece of felt and attach using the glue.
- **7**. Simply glue the clip to the back of your flower, securing with another piece of leftover felt if necessary.
