
## MATERIALS

- ☐ 1 m /1.1 yd fake fur seen at http://bit.ly/2zpvm9h
- Brocade fabric
- Diagonal stripe


## HOW-TO

- I. Sew side and shoulder seams.
- 2. Insert a seam pocket on the right side.
- 3. Close neckline seam and turn over with brocade.
- 4. Sew the sleeve seams.
- 5. Insert sleeves.
- 6. Sew the collar onto the neckline (this is best done by hand)
- 7. Fold edges inward and sew up by hand
- 8. Hand-hem the sleeves
- 9. Sew the sleeve cuffs and sew onto sleeves gathering sleeve fabric as necessary.
- IO. Brush the seams using a brush
- II. Fake fur is quite thick and not easy to sew. I cut the hair at the edge of the seams to make it easier to handle. I created a simple pattern as the seam pocket is a challenge in itself for a standard sewing machine. I trimmed some of the inner seams using diagonal stripe, which you can only do by hand anyway.

- Collar 2x fur, 2x brocade
