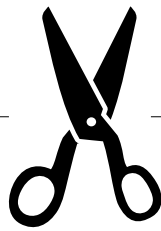

NAVY BLUE LACE DRESS

SIZE 36-38

MATERIALS

- 1, 2 m navy blue lace <http://bit.ly/2tgWcCn>
- leftover fabrics in white and navy blue
- seam zipper 30 cm
- 4 buttons

TUTORIAL

1. Add darts to the front and back pieces
2. Close the shoulder seams
3. Sew the side seams and make sure you pay attention to the zipper indication
4. Turn over the sleeve cut outs and sew on diagonal stripes by hand
5. Turn over the front edges with navy blue fabric
6. Prepare the button wholes
7. Put the front middle pieces on top of each other and quilt them
8. Sew the side seams of the skirt pieces and make sure to leave an opening for the zipper on the left
9. Attach the skirt to the top, put it in folds as indicated and sew it on
10. On the left, insert the zipper
11. Finish the collar and sew it to the neckline
12. Attach the buttons
13. Cut out the white collar, turn it over and close the open edges by hand
14. Sew the button wholes
15. Prepare the bow
16. Button the white collar to the dress collar
