MATERIALS

- ❑ Gauze fabric (e.g. old baby spit cloth; alternatively, you can use linen, silk or cotton). This can be dyed with black tea, ad I have done.
 - ❑ Dried flowers (e.g. straw flowers, Limonium, grains, herbs, thistle)
 - ❑ Satin ribbon
 - ❑ Wrapping paper, scissors, glue

- STEP 1** Wrap gift with white wrapping paper. Tear a ribbon from the gauze fabric (important for the frayed edge) and wrap it around the gift.
- STEP 2** Tie small mini bouquets of dried flowers & grasses and close with a bow made of satin ribbon.
- STEP 3** Attach to the gift (either with a small safety pin or hot glue).
